

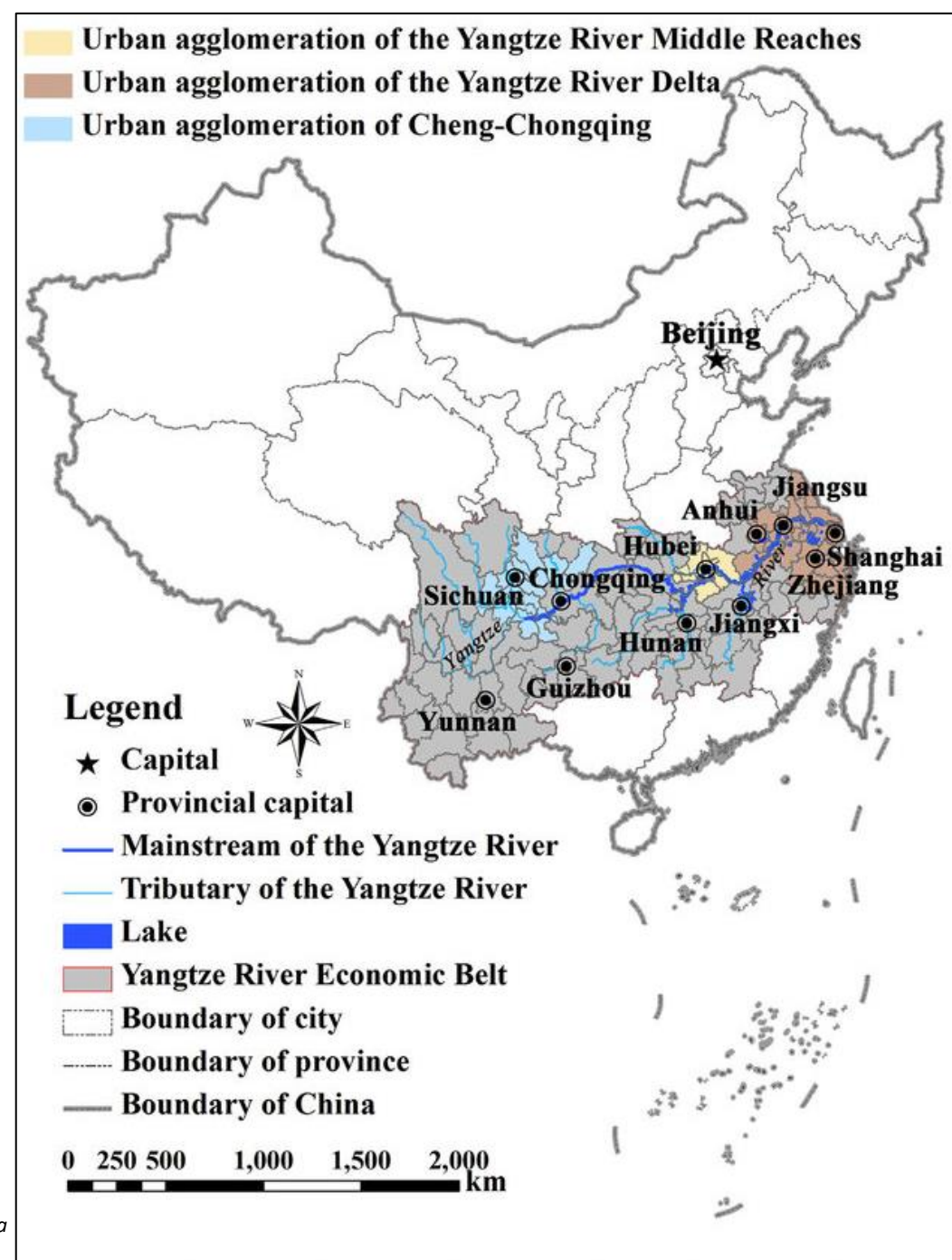

in Yangtze River, China*

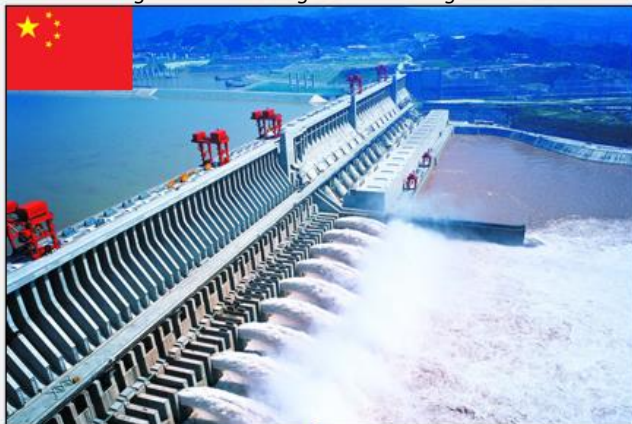
